

Safe unpacking instruction for your dogyards

Important Safety Notice:

To prevent injury or damage when unpacking your dogyard, please follow these instructions carefully. Failure to do so may result in serious injury.

Step-by-Step Guide

Position the Pallet

Step 1: Locate a Wall: Find a sturdy wall where the pallet can safely lean.

Step 2: Place the Pallet: Position the pallet close to the wall, ensuring it's stable and won't tip over.

Prepare to Cut Bands

Step 3: Vertical Plastic Bands: Start by carefully cutting the vertical plastic bands one by one. This helps to release some tension.



Secure the Top Sections

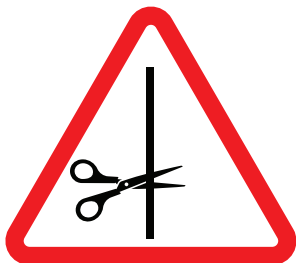
Step 4: Press and Hold: While standing to the side of the pallet, press against the top sections of the dogyard to ensure they stay in place.

Cut the Horizontal Band

Step 5: Horizontal Band: With one hand pressing the top sections, carefully cut the top horizontal band. This will allow the dogyard to tilt safely against the wall.

Lowering the Dogyard

Step 6: Slowly Lower: Allow the dogyard to slowly lean against the wall. Ensure your hands and body are clear of any potential pinch points.



Always cut the vertical bands first to avoid sudden release of tension.



Keep hands clear of any pinch points.



Never stand directly in front of the pallet while cutting bands.

Additional Tips

Use of Safety Equipment: Wear gloves and safety glasses to protect from sharp edges and potential splinters.

Assistance Recommended: If possible, have another person assist you during the unpacking process.
